Windows Server

Windows Server 2008 R2 isn't able to start Hyper-V - what can I do ? (Supermicro Mainboard)

=> This information pertains to servers with a Supermicro mainboard and AMD server CPU

Problem:

You receive the following error message under Microsoft Windows Server 2008 R2 when running a virtual machine under the Hyper-V Hypervisor:

"The virtual machine could not be started because the hypervisor is not running"

Solution:
